

ENTRIES MUST BE RECEIVED BY 5:00 PM ON WEDNESDAY, JULY 24TH, 2024.

Eligibility:

Anyone living, working, or attending school in Mayes County can enter. One entry per person. One winner will be selected from each age category: Children (5-11), Teens (12-17), and Adults (18+). Winners will see their art featured on our library card!

How to enter your artwork:

- 1.) Turn your art in on our paper template. You may recreate the template but keep the dimensions the same. Can be turned in by hand or mailed to: Pryor Public Library, 505 E. Graham Ave., Pryor, OK 74361.
- 2.) Email your entry to: programs@pryorlibrary.org. Digital entries must be in JPG or PNG format and may not exceed 1 MB in size. Artwork can include high resolution at least 300 PPI (300 x 300 resolution). Include an editable PDF file. Basic card dimensions are 2 1/8 inches by 3 3/8 inches (2.125 in x 3.375 in).

Other Important Info:

Artwork must be original and not published elsewhere. Submitted artwork becomes property of Pryor Public Library. The library will retain all submissions. Entries will be reviewed by members of the community. Pryor Public Library reserves the right to make the final selection and/or use or not use winning art. Art will not be returned at conclusion of the contest. There is no set date for artwork to appear on library cards. Library staff may modify winning artwork to meet production requirements. Winners will be notified by phone. Winners' names may appear in news media, social media, on the library's website and other communications. Celebrate this year's library summer reading program with us by entering our library card design contest! Winners will have their design printed on a batch of our library cards. Here's what you need to know:

Library Card Design Contest Rules and Regulations

- Anyone (ages 5 and up) living, working, or attending school in Mayes County is eligible to enter.
- The entry form must be completed in order to be eligible to win.
- One winner from each age category: Children (5-11), Teens (12-17), and Adults (18+).
- One submission per person. Do not include personal information in the artwork.
- Artwork must be original, not published elsewhere and free of any copyright restrictions.
- All designs must be completed on the template. You may recreate the template on your computer but must keep the dimensions the same and include all of the requested information.
- Artwork can include high resolution at least 300 PPI (300 x 300 resolution) computer-generated as well as digital photographic submissions or paper submissions using our template. If the art is digital please use JPG or PNG format (do not exceed 1 MB in size) and include an editable PDF file. Please keep in mind that with the reduction in size, some details may be lost. The basic card dimensions are 2 ½ inches by 3 ¾ inches (2.125 in x 3.375 in).
- Artwork cannot include any graphic or explicit content.
- Upon submission, entrants grant Pryor Public Library all rights to the artwork and consent that all artwork may be displayed and/or reproduced without limitation and without future compensation.
- Library staff may modify winning artwork to meet production requirements.
- If any entry violates these rules and regulations, it will be disqualified.
- The deadline to turn in entries is 5:00 PM on July 24th, 2024.

Judging

• Members of the community (e.g., City employees, Friends of the Library, and/or library staff) will select the finalists from each age group category.

Theme

- We are looking for designs that showcase the value of the Pryor Public Library, or what the library means to you.
- Three card designs will be selected and judged based on creativity, artistic expression, and the message communicated.

Award

- The winning designs will be used for official library cards and may be used on library promotional materials.
- Contest winners will be notified by phone.
- Winners' names may appear in news media, social media, on the library's website and other communications.
